



#### IN MEMORIAM

**Patricia Melanie Austin** passed away peacefully at home on October 19. Pat was president of Oceanids in 1973-74 and was active, with her husband Ros, in the Wine-Tasting Group for many years. She also was a very good bridge player and part of the Day Bridge interest group in years past. She came to San Diego in the very early 50s when her husband took a job with the Visibility Laboratory at the Scripps Institution of Oceanography.

Many Oceanids will remember **Rose Baily** who died on November 10. She had come with her husband Norman to La Jolla in 1968 where he served as professor of radiology and chief of the Division of Radiological Physics and Engineering in the new medical school of UCSD. Rose joined Oceanids and was president of the organization in 1974-75. For several years she was very much involved with consumer advocacy and worked with channel 39 in San Diego. We remember her tales about it, but more importantly to many, she was a wonderful, very capable bridgeplayer and very active in our bridge interest groups.

#### What's behind a Word? by Odette Filloux

Over the last few months I have had unfortunately many occasions to visit the office of numerous doctors where during the long hours I spent in their waiting rooms I also had ample time to stare at what was displayed on their walls and ponder over it.

One particular announcement I found exhibited wherever I went and that I had never seen before attracted my attention. It was titled: Notice to consumers, and went on to specify that medical doctors were licensed and regulated by the medical board of California; a phone number and an email address were also provided.

But I was not interested in the details, while what immediately struck and surprised me was the fact that we were, I along with all those trapped in their chairs around me, being hailed as "consumers".

As time would go by, I had all the necessary leisure to argue in my mind over and over again that by my definition consumers must necessarily consume as well as shoppers shop, dancers dance and dreamers dream, and I would keep wondering what it was that I was consuming as I was waiting here at the mercy of the doctor's schedule.

And I would go on to think that what I was really doing at that moment was above all waiting, waiting and hoping to be called soon and that it did require from me, as from others, a lot of "patience". I would then recall how "patience" did come from the Latin word "patienta" whose first meaning had been "the action of suffering, enduring, or bearing some sort of hardship", and I would reflect that if we were not necessarily suffering at the moment we were all at least enduring the wait and patiently expecting to be called in, looked at, listened to, examined, then hopefully diagnosed and offered various remedies for a possible cure. And so I would conclude that if we definitely were not "consumers" we were indeed in more ways than one eminently "patient" or "Patients". I had no doubt then that the announcement that irritated me should have read more appropriately: Notice to Patients and not Notice to Consumers.

For all along I had not been shopping for a tangible good that I would pay for and leave with. The physician who would see me would not provide me with a "thing" that I would bargain for and simply pay with a price we had debated. There was more to that visit than that. What would hopefully be provided for me here were for the most part, intangible things, like knowledge, attention, compassion, and care and if all this had a price, the price was not or at least should not be either the objective or the main concern.

In the end, I would conclude that what had really annoyed and angered me was the fact that through this word I had been forced here and now to think of myself as involved in some sort of business exchange in which I had choices and where I had come to buy, as at the corner store, the care of my doctor.

It colored my visit in a falsified light, totally altered both my position and that of the physician I was expecting to consult by reducing our relationship to a mere business transaction.

Just before the nurse would call me in I would repeat to myself that after my visit with my doctor it would not come to my mind to say that I had consumed "medicine", even if in a way prior to my visit and even now, as a patient, I had been and still was "consumed" by my illness.



Susan Shirk, Ph.D Director, Institute on Global Conflict and Cooperation and Ho Miu Lam Professor of China and Pacific Relations, IR/PS, UC San Diego

"China: Fragile Superpower"



Susan Shirk first traveled to China in 1971 and has been doing research there ever since. Shirk served as Deputy Assistant Secretary of State in the Bureau of East Asia and Pacific Affairs, with responsibility for China, Taiwan, Hong Kong and Mongolia from 1997-2000. She founded, and continues to lead the Northeast Asia Cooperation Dialogue (NEACD), an unofficial "track-two" forum for discussions of security issues among defense and foreign ministry officials and academics from the United States, Japan, China, Russia, and the Koreas. She is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations, and an emeritus member of the Aspen Strategy Group. As Senior Director at Albright Stonebridge Group, Shirk assists private sector clients with issues related to China and East Asia. Shirk received her Ph.D., at Massachusetts Institute of Technology.
