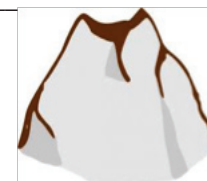

We are sorry to report the passing of **Shelly Schultz**, husband of Oceanids past President and life member Carol Schultz. Our condolences to Carol and their family.



Longtime Oceanid member **Sonia Hamburger** was born July 31, 1924 - and died February 8, 2017 in La Jolla. She was predeceased by her husband, Robert N. Hamburger, MD who had worked at UCSD for many years. She became one of the earliest medical anthropologists and established the first Menopause Hotline.

On May 25, as you enter the lobby/gallery of the **Mission Trails Regional Park Visitor and Interpretive Center**, replete with original stone sculptures, pottery, baskets, and ongoing art exhibits, you will gaze out of floor-to-ceiling



windows onto splendorous Mission Gorge. The award-winning 4,000 square foot Center is situated at the heart of the Park and provides an unforgettable view of the rugged ridges of Cowles Mountain, Pyles Peak, Kwaay Paay Mountain and Fortuna Mountain, as well as a unique view of the San Diego River running through Mission Gorge. The park, started in 1974, encompasses 7,220

acres of both natural and developed recreational acres. It represents San Diego prior to the landing of Cabrillo in San Diego Bay in 1542. Mission Trails Regional Park is considered the third Jewel in the City of San Diego Park System and is one of the largest urban parks in the United States. Originally used by the Kumeyaay, the park is the site of the Old Mission Dam, built to store water for the Mission San Diego de Alcalá.

SOUNDING BOARD

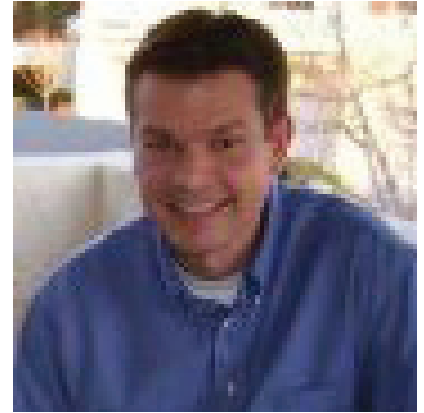

Robert A. Clossin, AICP, Director, UC San Diego Department of Physical & Community Planning

“UCSD Campus Transformation and Long Range Plan”

The presentation will provide an overview of UC San Diego’s physical design framework, a Long Range Development Plan update (which charts growth of the campus to 2035) and an overview of the campus’s strategic 5-year capital improvements plan. Mr. Clossin will also discuss the status of the Light Rail Transit project that has started construction.



Robert Clossin is the Director of Campus Planning. This unit is responsible for the development and implementation of campus plans, land use and site planning, compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and coordination with outside planning agencies and local communities. Robert has a Bachelor’s Degree in Urban Studies and Planning from UC San Diego, a Master’s of City Planning degree from San Diego State University, and is a member of the American Institute of Certified Planners (AICP).

Bess Marcus, Ph.D.

Professor and Chair of the Department of Family Health and Public Health; Senior Associate Dean for Public Health, School of Medicine, UC San Diego

The field of public health is central to addressing some of the most pressing health issues we face today, such as rising health care costs and the need for greater prevention of disease and disability across the lifespan. For more than 25 years, Dr. Marcus has directed research aimed at promoting exercise adherence and understanding the acquisition and maintenance of exercise behavior. Over the past 10 years her research has focused on increasing physical activity among underserved and vulnerable populations.

Dr. Marcus earned her MS and PhD degrees in clinical psychology from Auburn University, with a fellowship in Behavioral Medicine at Brown University. She has published more than 200 peer-reviewed articles. Her colleagues have recognized her with numerous awards, including the “Women Who Mean Business” Award from San Diego Business Journal and the UC San Diego Equal Opportunity/Affirmative Action and Diversity Award from UC San Diego.
