Oceanids Gallery of Arts + Crafts

Oceanids' virtual gallery today explores the decorative or folk art of tole. We present the tole collection of Barbara Bank, long time Oceanids and our Board's Parliamentarian.

Tole, which is a French word meaning tin, began in the 18th century in Germany. The art form quickly spread to other European countries, especially Holland, Norway and Sweden. German immigrants settling in Pennsylvania brought the culture and techniques of tole with them. Tole encompasses the painting of everyday household items, on tin or wood for the most part, to enhance or decorate them. Originally, it involved oil paint and lacquer to protect the paint and retain the item's usefulness. Today, acrylics are widely used. Flowers, fruit, color and patterns are the usual subjects of tole, but holiday, family and humorous themes can also be a focus. Antique tole work, especially that on tin, is highly collectible and can be expensive. Tole painting in North America was revived in the 1960s, but later waned as evidenced by the closing of the Society of Decorative Painters and Museum of Decorative Arts. Two local chapters of the Society still exist.

Barbara has some 20 pieces of artists' tole in her collection and over 100 pieces of her own decorative work, primarily on furniture. Here she presents four pieces in her collection by renown American tole artists with whom she has taken classes over the last 30+ years. All works are painted on wood. First is a work on carved wood by Jo Sonja Jansen, considered the foremost decorative artist in America today.

Many of you may recognize tole work but did not know that we have an Oceanids member practicing the art of tole. Thank you, Barbara, for sharing your collection with us.
