The Fall Quarter at UCSD starts as I am writing this. However, the foreign student office at UCSD still doesn't know how many international students we will have this year. The Oceanids Newcomers Committee is going ahead and planning as if the international



students will be able to get their interviews and visas soon. We have some exciting events planned.

The first event is coming up soon. On Sunday November 2, Chris Chase and Liz Fong Wills will take international students and scholars to Barrio Logan to see the pillars of Chicano Park painted in the style of Diego Rivera, along with some ofrendas (home alters) for Day of the Dead. The idea is to show the new international students and scholars some aspects of California's diverse communities that they might not be aware of. We will see people celebrating the Mexican holiday to honor and remember deceased loved ones by welcoming their spirits back to visit the living. We will see some ofrendas decorated with photos, favorite foods and drinks, along with possessions of the

deceased. Day of the Dead (Dia de los Muertos) is a cultural celebration that blends Indigenous pre-Columbian traditions and Spanish Catholic customs. Liz knows of a good (and inexpensive) Mexican lunch place. We will finish by jumping back on to the Trolley and going to Old Town to see the festival's commercial celebration with dancers and lots of mariachi music. There will be shops where students can buy tchotchkes to send home. Note: Many of the 58 participants on the first year we did this outing were from Spain or Central South America, and they had never heard of Dia de los Muertos and wanted to see what this Mexican holiday was all about! All of us learned something in the 7 hour excursion into another world!



IN MEMORIAM

We are very sorry to report the passing of Oceanid Carole Ziegler on May 10. Carole was born in Chicago in 1946. She was President of Oceanids for three years and was a very active member for many years, including with People to People. She regularly led camping trips in the Anza Borrego Desert for Newcomers. She had a personal project to back-pack the Pacific Crest Trail, in order. On May 10, 2025 she was backpacking the PCT with a former student at mile 600 in the mountains of the Sequoia National Forest and suffered a fatal cardiac arrest. She earned a Masters degree in geochemistry in Washington D.C.. For the past 20 years Carole taught geology and geography at Southwestern College. She will be missed.





Oceanid Lucie Walther passed away in June, 2025. She will be remembered fondly by many Oceanids for her energy, enthusiasm and competence in so many of her activities she enjoyed. She was an active member of Cafe Francais and was a big help with membership mailings of renewal letters and directories. She was awarded the Maxine E. White Outstanding Service Award in 2011 for her efforts. In addition to having her own mailing and shipping business, she was an avid tennis player. Lucie was born in the small village of Courchapoix in Switzerland. She came to the US as an au pair and met her husband in English classes. Lucie and her husband both passed away in 2025 and are survived by their two daughters Jacqueline and Peggy and twin grandchildren.
